Course Description: This training provides teachers with the content knowledge, processes and skills necessary to develop and implement Orton-Gillingham lesson plans to meet the needs of diverse learners in classroom or small group. Associate Part 2 is required to provide one-on-one instruction.

Cost Includes: 40 hours coursework and materials only. Does NOT include Practicum supervision.

Practicum OGCE

Classroom Educator / Associate Part 1—School Year 2021-22

Course Description: The practicum is a course of study to provide Orton-Gillingham Classroom Educator (OGCE) trainees/teachers an opportunity to become familiar with the principles of the approach and deepen their knowledge of English language structures. OG is a student centered approach. Throughout the year-long supervised practicum, teachers become competent at identify potential gaps in their students learning and modify instruction for classroom or small groups.

*Prerequisite: Satisfactory completion of Classroom Educator/Associate Part 1 Course and background check

Minimum Requirements: *(for a complete list visit www.ortonacademy.org).*

1. The supervised application of 50 contact hours extends over a minimum of eight consecutive months to increase teacher competency in design and implementation of OG instruction in classroom and small group settings.
2. OGCE trainees/teachers must provide a minimum of two lessons weekly on non-consecutive days for 40 to 60 minutes each.
3. Successful completion of 5 observations of complete lesson plans.
4. Completion and documentation of required readings and assignments.

Cost Includes: Year-long 50 hour supervised practicum; 5-7 practicum observations, digital binder, and monthly video conference.
