

# 2022 Orton-Gillingham Approach Teacher/Tutor Training for Dyslexia and Literacy Instruction <u>On-Line Course</u>

Instructors: Nancy Redding, F/OGA and Lori Shikuma, FIT/OGA

#### Classroom Educator (CE) Course: (40 hours) \$900

#### Dates: June 14-22, 2022

**Times:** This class is a mix of live Zoom sessions and pre-recorded webinars. Live sessions will take place June 14–17 and 20-22 from 9:30 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. <u>PDT</u> (28 hours). Pre-recorded webinars will take approximately 12 hours to complete.

Registrants who desire CE training *only* should be employed by a public or private school. This training prepares a teacher for implementing the Orton Gillingham Approach within a classroom or small group, and also leads to Associate Level training for 1:1 tutoring.

### Associates Level Course: (65 hours) \$900 + \$400 = \$1300

#### Dates: June 14-22 and July 5-8, 2022

**Times:** June course days/times listed above. July 5-8, 2022, live sessions will be <u>9:30 a.m.–2:00</u> <u>p.m.</u> PDT (16 hours total). Pre-recorded webinars will take approximately 9 hours to complete.

The <u>Associate</u> level coursework of the Orton-Gillingham Academy will be taught in two sessions: the 7-day training from June 14-22 followed by a 4-day training July 5-8. The Associate level prepares individuals to teach one-on-one, and with any size group. See topics covered below.

### Classroom Educator: June 14-22, 2022

- The Reading Brain
- Dyslexia and reading disorders
- The rationale for structured literacy, in particular the OG Approach
- Phonology and phonological/phonemic awareness
- The motor component, orthography of English, and writing process
- Basic and intermediate phonics for reading and spelling
- The OG lesson plan and teaching materials
- General history of the English language and beginning morphology
- Informal Assessment and diagnostic-prescriptive teaching
- Achieving accuracy, automaticity, and fluency in reading and spelling

## Additional topics for Associate Level: July 5-8, 2022

- Interpreting formal assessments
- Vocabulary development
- Grammar and basic writing skills
- Paragraph writing
- Reading Comprehension
- Providing direct 1:1 instruction
- The Academy's philosophy, standards, and certification requirements

The total cost of CE coursework is \$900; total cost for Associate coursework is \$1300. Course fee includes the training manual, Student Notebook, and 4 decks of drill cards. Participants must provide some supplies. A list of required readings and supplies is provided upon registration.
